	Upon arrival in Taipei International Airport, proceed on your own to connect with your connecting flight for Denpasar..

	Meet upon arrival and transfer to your hotel in Denpasar, Bali. Bali has a deep-seated and singular spirituality. A lonely Hindu enclave in the predominantly Muslim Indonesian archipelago of 17,500 islands, its unique variant of faith is a composite of Indian cosmology, Tantric Buddhism, local animist traditions and ancestor worship. Rock-cut temples are tucked into verdantly layered rice terraces; divine images that line the sand are periodically anointed with thick colored powder; little hand-woven baskets filled with fruit, petals and rice grain offerings are scattered in the streets, to the delight of stray dogs. <b>OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION : MAYA UBUD RESORT</b>		
<b>DAY 03</b>	<b>DENPASAR</b>		
	This morning visit Goa Lawah is known as the “bat cave” since the inner court of the temple is exactly that, a large, open-faced cave inhabited by thousands of bats. This is one of the most sacred sites on the island to devout Balinese. It is believed that the cave stretches for miles from Goa Lawah (which is on the coast) all the way to Besakih and is said to contain the great cosmic naga (dragon-snake) Basuki. The beach opposite is often the site of the “middle step” in the complex series of Balinese cremation ceremonies that occur for years after a person passes on. Next stop is <b>Tenganan Village</b> , located on the <b>eastern part of Bali</b> . This traditional village with traditional weaving to make Balinese Sarong, Syal and traditional dress. Lunch at Local Restaurant. Visit Puri Agung Kanganin Karangasem.

**Puri Agung Kanginan** is a 19th century princely palace. This palace consists of three parts: Bengingah (where traditional festivals held), gardens, and residential apartments of the princely family. Here we will enter through a gate guarded by lions. There is an artificial pond with a pavilion, the Balekambang. We can also see decoration that depict scenes from the Ramayana. Within the main palace precinct, we can find Bale London, a building which has richly carved doors and well paintings. Beside the building is the Bale Pemandesan, in which the ritual tooth-filing was performed. There also an audience hall called Puri Madura, also known as the Maskerdam.



This afternoon visit Ujung Water Castle. Taman Ujung Water Castle is a beautiful park with big fish pond surrounds the old Karangasem Empire heritage building which is used by the Karangasem's King for day relaxation or meeting place in their era. It is located in Ujung Countryside about 5 Km from Amlapura town.. End the day with a visit to the Art Market. Dinner at local restaurant



## DAY 04

### DENPASAR

Your full day tour today will visit the Besakih Temple, Besakih is “The Mother” temple – the most important temple in all of Bali. We have made special arrangements for the group to make an offering (“daksina”) and to receive a blessing and join in a brief Balinese Hindu ceremony with one of Besakih’s High



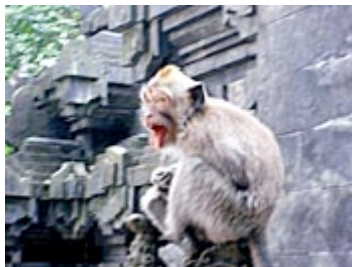
Priests. Besakih is dedicated to Siwa (Shiva) – but it also houses a number of other temples which mirror the temples around the entire island. So we will spend

the morning traveling around the Besakih complex to visit each of these smaller directional temples – creating the sacred mandala pilgrimage in miniature. Lunch at Restaurant Puri Boga. Conclude your day with a Sunset Dinner Cruise. Enjoy a welcome cocktail, canapé and a floral lei. There is also a live cabaret show on deck.

## **DAY 05 DENPASAR**

We'll experience the country life of traditional Bali in scenic Gulingan village – set amongst rice fields and forests – where we'll learn about how temple offerings are made from the beautiful local plants and flowers. Then we'll be treated to a traditional meal of “Babi Guling” the famous Balinese roast suckling pig (vegetarian food will also be made available).

### **AFTERNOON VISIT TO SANGEH MONKEY FOREST AND TANAH LOT TEMPLE (SUNSET)**



Next we visit the Sacred Monkey Forest of Sangeh and then head to Pura Tanah Lot, one of Bali's most picturesque and revered temples – one of the “Sea Temples” founded by the monk Niratha in the 16th century – If the tide permits we will cross the tidal pool and visit the inner courtyard.

## **DAY 06 DENPASAR/JIMBARAN BAY**

This morning free for own activities. This afternoon transfer to Jimbaran Bay, located at the southern part of the island of Bali.

A wholeday at leisure. Optional Glass bottom boat out to Turtle Island.with turtle conservation located in **Tanjung Benoa**, southern part of Bali.

**DAY 08 JIMBARAN BAY**

A wholeday free for own activities. This evening conclude your vist to Bali as you witness a colossal Kechak ritual with 2000 performers, sitting around a large burning torch, depict the battle of Prince Rama versus the evil King Ravana, and the rescue of Princess Sita, who has been kidnapped by King Ravana.

The choruses of men provide the orchestral accompaniment with complex and varied chants that accompany their swaying movements. The only music to accompany them are the beats of their palms hitting their chests, their thighs, or their claps. Flickering torches provide lighting and an enchanting atmosphere. Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant.
