**BANGKOK ARRIVAL**

Meet and Welcome by GTB Representative wearing a distinctive uniform holding signage displaying company name/logo.

After passport and immigration formalities, each participant obtains a luggage cart and collects their luggage personally from the carousel. After baggage reclaim, participants pass through customs individually and exit into the arrival hall where a team of porters will assist with baggage. The luggage having been tagged and clearly marked, is placed onboard the same vehicle and sent directly to the guest rooms, which are pre-allocated.

The participants are transferred by deluxe coached (air-conditioned Mercedes Benz 40 seater coaches). Light Thai classical music will be played as background music. During the transfer to the hotel, the GTB Representative will provide a commentary including an overview of the visit and key points of interest enroute. Guides will be fluent in English.

Room keys are placed in envelopes and laid out in alphabetical order for collection.

### **Venice of the East & The Grand Palace (0900-1200 hrs)**

Then visit the Grand Palace -- Thailand's most historically famous palace. It was built in 1782 and has since been the seat of the country's power. It is an exuberant piece of architecture – breathtaking with its mix of golden domes, fluted spires and glittering temples. Most importantly the grounds of the Grand Palace houses the Temple of The Emerald Buddha, the Kingdom's most precious and revered image of Lord Buddha. It is one visit not to be missed.

Lunch at Supatra River House Restaurant.

This two-storey traditional Thai house on the banks of the Chao Phraya River near to the Temple of Dawn is steeped in Thai history. The home belonged to Khunying Supatra Singholaga, a successful business lady and an advocate of women' rights in Thai society in her days. In memory of her mother, daughter Supapan has converted the house into a first-class restaurant and dinner theatre, complete with memorabilia of the past, that recreate the days of old Siam and offer a unique experience to the guests.
